If a client cancels the tour for personal reasons after the conclusion of the Tour Contract, the client shall pay the cancellation fees described below.

Cancellation Policy	
(a) If cancellation is made on or after the 20th day (10th day if the tour is an one-day trip) prior to the day preceding the date of commencement of the travel	20% of the tour fee
(b) If cancellation is made on or after the 7th day prior to the day preceding the date of commencement of the travel (excluding the cases mentioned in (c) through (e))	30% of the tour fee
(c) If cancellation is made on the day preceding the date of commencement of the travel	40% of the tour fee
(d) If cancellation is made on the date of commencement of the travel (excluding the case mentioned in (e));	50% of the tour fee
(e) In case of cancellation after the commencement of the travel or of non-participation without communication	100% of the tour fee
