This Privacy Notice is issued to you, Data Subject, to inform you of our collection, access, use and process your personal data.

1. Categories of personal data

We hereby inform you that we collect, use and process the following categories of your personal data:

- Name
- Address
- Country of Residence
- Phone Number
- Email Address
- Affiliation name

2. Legal basis and purpose:

As per Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, we hereby inform you that we use your personal data for the purpose of providing you following services:

- Registrations
- Application to the congress related events
- Issuing congress materials (such as abstract books, name cards and etc.)
Providing Visa related documents

In addition, your personal data may be converted into statistical or aggregated data which cannot be used to identify you and then used to produce statistical research and reports. This aggregated data may be shared and used in the ways described above.

PSE2021+ processes your personal data in its interest as well as your interest, so PSE2021+ provides and you receive the congress related supplies that you have requested and other related materials specified in the above.

3. Retention periods

We keep your personal data as long as there is a statutory or legal requirement to do so or in order to provide the aforementioned services to you. For accounting or auditing purposes we may retain your personal data for a period of time after our direct business dealings have ended.

4. Data storage and transfer

Furthermore, we may share your personal data with JTB group companies as well as with other companies which may be located within or outside the EEA and provide congress related services.

5. Prior consent
