

Privacy Policy (for Participants from the European Union)

1. Data Controller

The Local Organizing Committee of KAKIOKA2026 (the “LOC”) acts as the data controller for the processing of personal data.

2. Personal Data We Collect

We may collect and process the following personal data when you register for the workshop:

- Name
- Affiliation and position
- Email address
- Country of residence
- Registration details (e.g. participant type, attendance status)
- Presentation-related information (if applicable)

3. Purpose of Processing

Your personal data are processed solely for the following purposes:

- Managing and administering registration for the workshop
- Communicating with participants regarding the workshop
- Organizing the scientific and administrative program
- Fulfilling accounting and record-keeping obligations related to participation

Your personal data will not be used for commercial marketing purposes.

4. Legal Basis for Processing

The legal basis for processing your personal data is Article 6(1)(b) GDPR (performance of a contract). Where applicable, explicit consent under Article 6(1)(a) GDPR may also apply.

5. Use of a Registration Service Provider

The LOC uses an external service provider as a data processor and the provider processes personal data only on documented instructions of the LOC, in accordance with Article 28 GDPR.

6. International Data Transfers

Personal data may be processed and stored in Japan. Japan is recognized by the European Commission as providing an adequate level of data protection under Article 45 GDPR.

7. Data Retention

Personal data will be retained only as long as necessary for the purposes described above. Registration data will generally be deleted within one year after the workshop, except where longer retention is required by law.

8. Rights of Data Subjects

You have the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict or object to processing of your personal data, and where applicable, the right to data portability, in accordance with the GDPR.

9. Right to Lodge a Complaint

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in the EU.
