

PSILPH2026 Registration Privacy Notice by Organizer

1. Introduction

2. Personal Data We Collect

3. Purpose of Use

Personal data will be used for the following purposes:

Registration management and identity verification

Payment processing and fee management

Preparation of the program and abstract book

Presentation and event management

Visa support documentation

Communication with participants (including important updates)

Venue operations and safety management

Statistical analysis and service improvement (in anonymized form)

4. Third-Party Sharing and Processing

The Committee may share or entrust personal data with/to third parties to the extent necessary to achieve the above purposes, including:

Payment service providers

Registration system providers
Printing and publishing vendors
Venue management providers
Travel and accommodation agencies (if applicable)
IT service providers
The Committee does not sell personal data.

5. International Data Transfers

Personal data may be transferred to and processed in countries outside the participant's country of residence where necessary for the operation of the conference. In such cases, appropriate safeguards will be implemented in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

6. Retention Period

Personal data will be retained for approximately three (3) years after the conclusion of the conference. However, it may be retained longer if required for accounting, legal, or archival purposes.
